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How do I view and print club mailing labels?

ClubRunner can access the address information in your member directory to output a PDF document suitable for printing on standard Avery labels. This makes addressing club correspondence faster.

- 1. To access the mailing label feature, you must first go to your club homepage and log in. Then, click on **Member Area**on the top right, under your club banner.
- 2. Along the top of the screen you will see several tabs. Click on the **Admin** tab, and then on the **Admin** feature below it.
- Scroll down to the Reports Dashlet on the Admin Dashboard and click Printable Mailing List.
- 4. You are now on the **Printable Mailing Labels** screen. To generate a PDF of the most recent member addresses, click on the button marked **Generate**.

This process may take a few minutes. Once the page has refreshed, click on the "View PDF" button to download the report.
