- **Height**: This sets the height for the header in pixels.
- **Background Image**: This sets the background for the header. Click the Select an image for the background. You can select an image or

click **Browse** and **Upload** to upload a new image from your computer. C is the

icon to remove the background.

- Left Logo: This sets the left logo for the header. Click the Set edit icon to select an image for the logo. You can select an image or click **Browse** and then **Upload** to upload a new image from your computer. Click the set delete icon to remove the logo.
- **Right Logo**: This sets the right logo for the header. Click the Section to select an image for the logo. You can select an image or click **Browse** and then **Upload** to upload a new image from your computer. Click the section to remove the logo.
- **Content**: This sets the text on the header. Click the Set edit icon to open the online editor which will allow you to enter text, links and more into the header. To remove the text, please click on the Set edit icon and erase all of the text.
