


[NOVA] How can I quickly log in without my username / password?

Sometimes you will need to log in to the club's or district's website but won't have time to go through the password reset process. In that case, the **Magic Link** option will be helpful. To quickly log in through the Magic Link, simply follow the steps below:

1. Navigate to your club's or district's login page, or to our [Universal Login page](#).
2. Click on the **Send me a Magic Link** option, below the Login button.
