

Deleted Bulletins are not available for restoration. If you have accidentally deleted a bulletin, please reach out to our Support team, with the Bulletin's title & date.


- 1. In order to **Delete** a bulletin, you must login to your club's website and then enter the **Member Area**.

- Click on the View All Bulletins link in the menu on the left side of the page, under the Getting Started section.




Deleting an Active Bulletin

1. A warning message will appear to confirm your selection. Click **Ok** to delete the active bulletin.




1. On the Active Bulletins page, click the **Active Bulletins dropdown** just below the page title, then click **Archived Bulletins**.

Active Bulletins




1. On the Archived Bulletins List page, locate the bulletin to delete within the list, then click the Actions **dropdown arrow** on the right side of the page.
