

How do I manage my club's Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) settings?

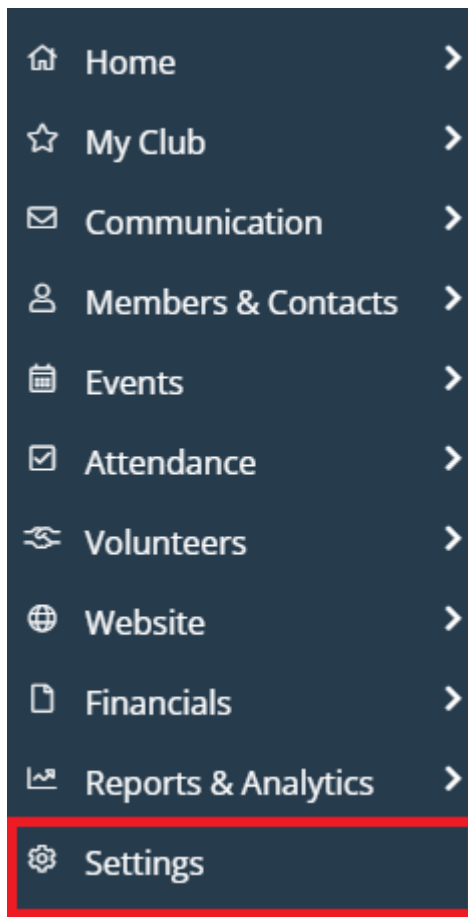
Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) is a security process that requires users to provide two or more authentication factors from different categories, such as passwords, biometrics, or authentication tokens, to access a system or account. When MFA is enabled for a role, all users in that role will be required to enter a verification code sent to their primary email address each time they log in.

Note

Only members with level 30-Site Administrator access will be able to edit the MFA settings for the club.

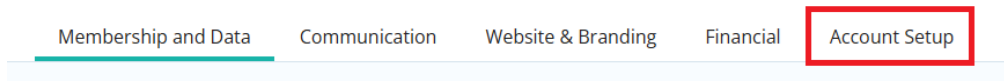
To manage your club's MFA settings, follow these steps:
