

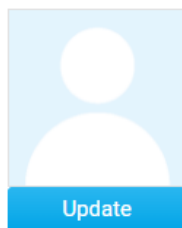
How do I stop communications/emails from my club?

If a member wants to stop some or all communications from the Club please follow the steps below.

1. To start, you must go to your club homepage and login. Then, click on **Member Area** on the top right.
2. Along the top of the screen you will see several tabs. Click on the **My ClubRunner** tab.
3. Next, click on the **My Profile** link under My ClubRunner.
4. You are now on your Member Profile screen, click on the **Privacy** tab.
