
You can view and change the point values used in the **Member Activity** and **Club Activity** report by using the **Participation Points** page.

Note: Members need to have access level 30 - Administrator, 40 - President, or 50 - Executive to access this page. To learn how to change a member's access level please read the document called <u>Changing a Member's Access Level</u>.

1. Login to ClubRunner by clicking on the **Member Login** link near the top right of the Club's website. Enter your login name and password.



2. Click the **Member Area** link, near the top right.



3. On the grey menu bar near the top click **Organization**.



4. On the blue menu bar click **Participation Points**.



- 5. This takes you to the **Participation Points** page. From here you can see how many points each type is worth.
 - Edit All This button allows you to edit all of the type point values at once.
 Please see step 6 for more details.
 - Edit This allows you to edit the point value on a line.

o Reset to default - This resets the type value to the default value.


