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## [NOVA] How do I export my club's financial information for use in QuickBooks?

ClubRunner Nova allows you to export financial invoices and payments to a CSV file that you can manually import into QuickBooks.

### Exporting Invoices

1. To navigate to the Invoices screen, on the left-hand menu click the arrow to the right of **Financials**, then click on **Invoices**.



2. Click the check box next to the invoices you want to export. You can use the check box at the top of the list to select all invoices from the current page or all invoices in the account.
3. With all invoices checked that you want to export, click the arrow icon on the right of the **Export To Excel** button, then select **Export Invoice QB** from the dropdown.

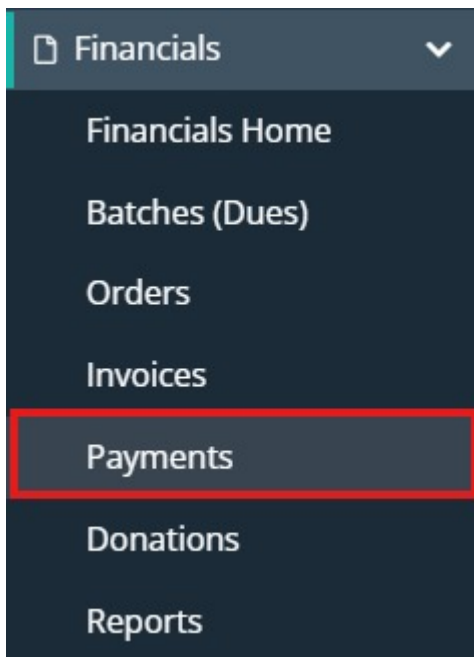

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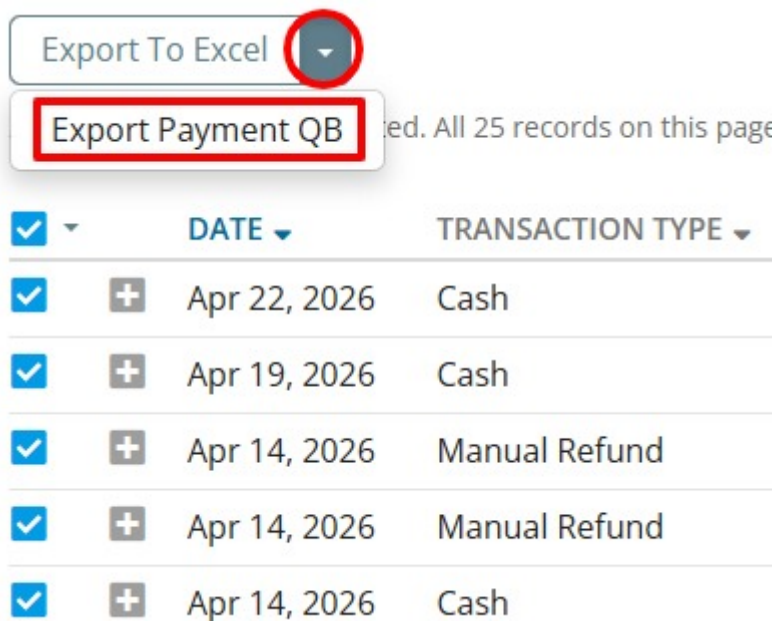

## Exporting Payments
