Locating the Rule of 85 Report

The report can be found by following these steps:

- 1. Login to the admin page
- 2. Click on the "Reports" tab on the menu bar
- 3. Click on "Rule of 85"



Rule of 85 Report

The report will detail the following information:

- 1. Member's name Displayed ascending order by last name
- 2. Age The member's age
- 3. Years of Service Member's years of service from the date joined.

Information can be sorted by:

- Member
- Age
- · Date Joined
- Years of Service
- Age + Year of Service

Note: The report will only display the member's name if both the **date of birth** and **date joined** are entered on their member's profile.
